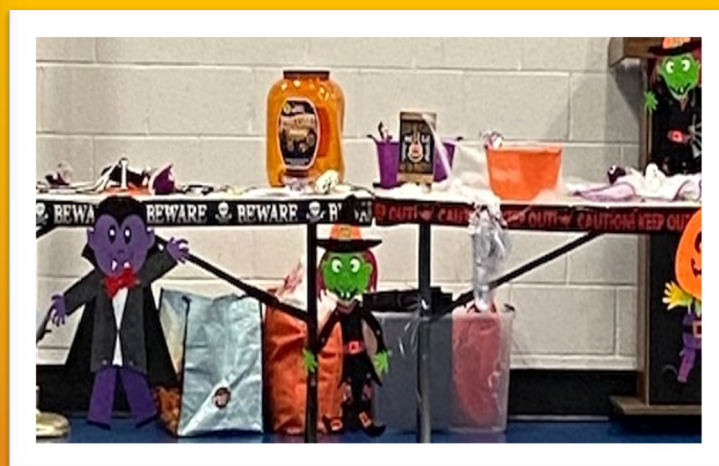


### Trick or Treat Safety Rules

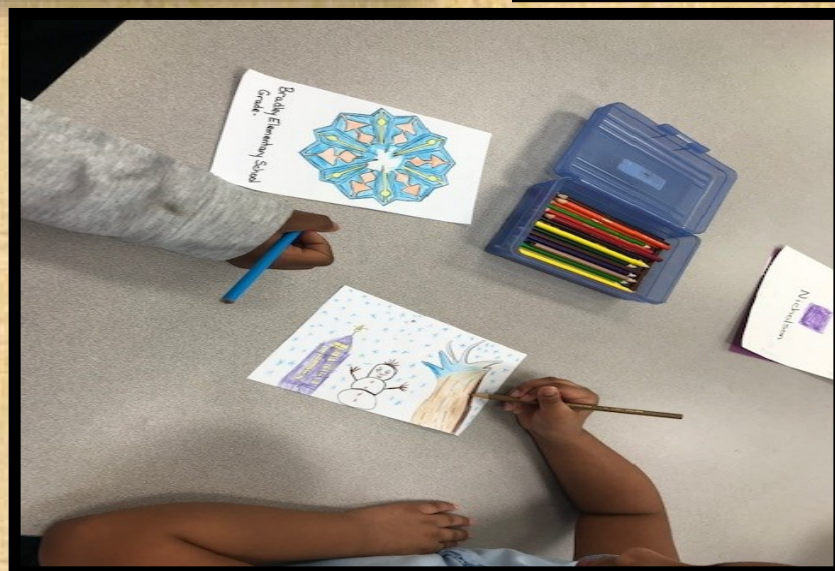




# And the winners are...



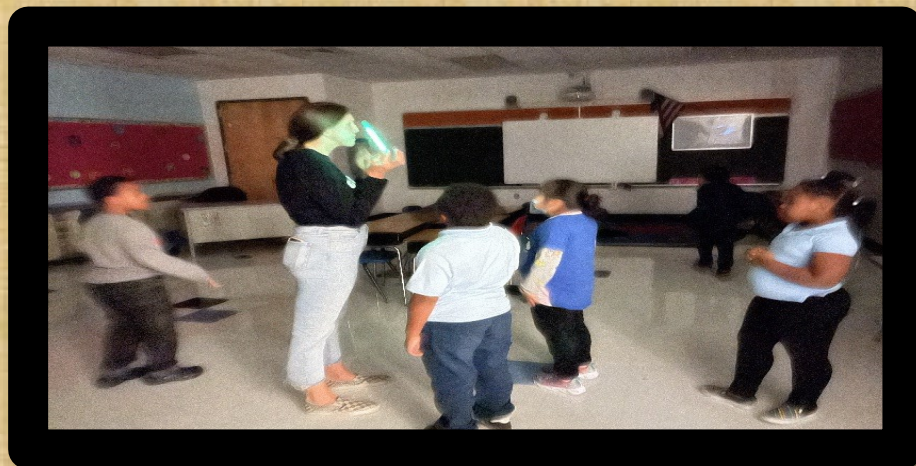
